EASIER TO HANDLE

HOOK design for easier handling (the hook can be hung for opening with one hand).

EASIER TO OPEN AND CLOSE

MAGNETIC CAP for easier opening and closing for users with limited muscle strength and allowing for auditory confirmation for visually impaired users.

EASIER TO IDENTIFY

BRAILLE LABELING for the visually impaired makes it easily identified by touch.

EASIER TO APPLY

Bottom GRIP that requires limited to no finger movement. LARGER ROLLERBALL to cover more surface area in one swipe as additional movement is difficult for people with disabilities.

REFILLABLE

REFILLABLE design to reduce plastic consumption.
